



An Introduction to Elementary Reporting in PowerSchool

After logging in to the PowerSchool parent portal, you will see the landing page which looks similar to this screen:

To view your child's progress in a certain subject, click on the **NA** in the Y1 column.

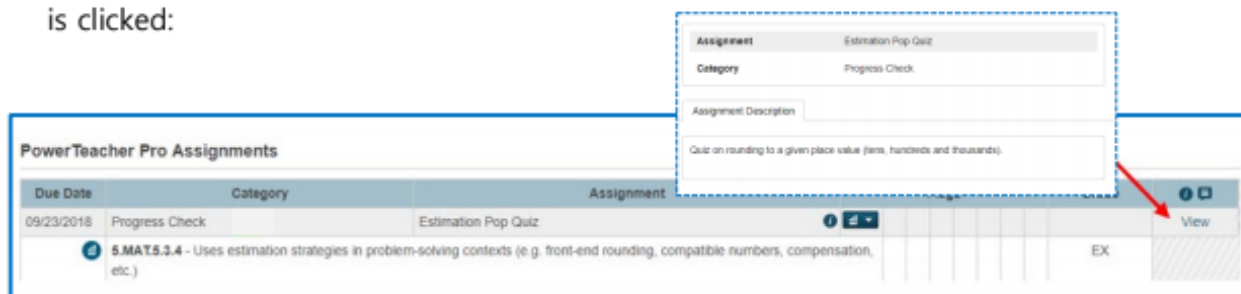
As teachers add assessment tasks to their gradebooks, you will see a real-time view of your child's achievement. You will see the name and dates of assessments for your child.

Other information which may be included:

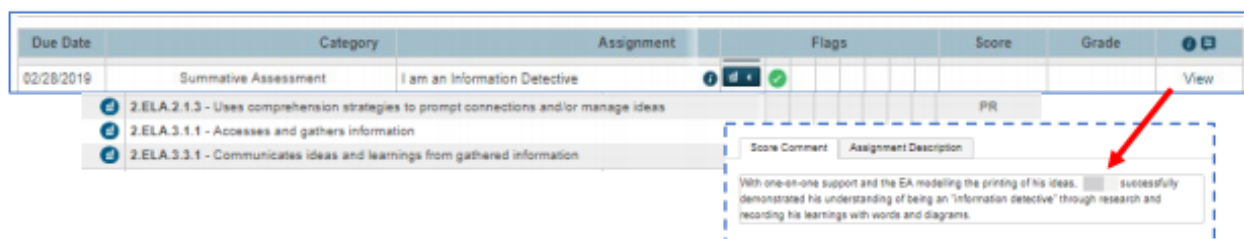
- An Indicator showing if an assignment was missed, incomplete or late. Here is an example:

- Information about the individual assessment (such as a link, success criteria or rubric, or explanation of the assignment or portion of the outcome which is the focus of the assessment.) Here is an example of the new window that will appear with assignment information when *View* is clicked:



- An occasional comment related to the specific assignment, directed to the student, to inform the child's progress or next steps in learning. As shown in the example here, the parent would click *View* to see the comment open in a new window.
